Education

Capital

Through our microloan program, we offer loans up to \$50,000 with highly competitive fixed interest rates.

We organize networking opportunities for our clients with other lowa professionals and link them to niche small business specialists. We host speed networking events, peer mentoring groups, lunch and learns and motivational speakers, all with the goal in mind of building our clients' networks and raising the visibility of small businesses.



How We Do It...

Asset Development

- Loans of up to \$50,000 for lowa for-profit businesses

- Pre-loan credit education
- Free year-round tax prep and planning through Volunteer Income Tax Assistance and EITC Program (VITA) taxes for individuals, families and sole proprietors

Sessions are virtual and run quarterly





